

Status of Block Island Trails

Updated: April 24, 2026

The February Blizzard severely impacted the walking trails on Block Island and many remain impassable. The amount of trail damage is unprecedented, and we ask for people's patience while the conservation groups and Adrian's Army of volunteers work on restoring the trails.

Below is a list of trails that are passable. Some may require ducking around tree limbs.

- Clay Head Bluff Trail (Long lot trail and interior trails are not passable)
- Hodge Preserve
- Fresh Swamp Preserve
- Fresh Pond Preserve through to Rodman's Hollow
- Black Rock Road and portions of Rodman's Hollow
- Lewis-Dickens Trail
- Portions of trails at Turnip Farm, Enchanted Forest and Loffredo Loop
- Portion of the Greenway just south of Beacon Hill
- Portion of Harrison Loop and the Greenway from West Side Rd to cemetery

We plan to update this list as more trails are reopened.
