

Status of Block Island Trails

Updated: May 29, 2026

We are still working on restoring the walking trails that were severely impacted by the February Blizzard. The amount of trail damage is unprecedented, and we ask for people's patience while the conservation groups and Adrian's Army of volunteers work on restoring the trails.

Below is a list of trails that are passable. Some might be tight and require ducking around tree limbs.

- Black Rock Road and portions of Rodman's Hollow used for Shad Bloom Run
- Clay Head Bluff Trail (Long lot trail and interior trails are not passable)
- Fresh Pond Preserve through to Rodman' Hollow
- Fresh Swamp Preserve
- Portion of the Greenway just south of Beacon Hill
- Portion of Harrison Loop and the Greenway from West Side Rd to cemetery
- Hodge Preserve
- Lewis-Dickens Trail
- Portions of trails at Nathan Mott, Turnip Farm, Enchanted Forest and Loffredo Loop
- Ocean Ave Trail by Dunns Bridge
- Win Dodge (main trail is passable but more work is needed on the Hill Loop)

We plan to update this list as more trails are reopened.
